



## Uraidla Primary School Uniform Policy

The Uraidla Primary School uniform is based on the Department for Education Administration Instructions and Guidelines, and supports child protection and social justice principles. It is expected that all students will follow this uniform policy. This involves the wearing of the school colours red and navy blue, the wearing of hats and appropriate footwear.



The following Uraidla PS items marked with a \* are available for purchase directly through the school, via a bulk order twice a year, with order forms sent home to all families. Most items can also be purchased at Worklocker in the Homemaker Centre, Dutton Road, Mount Barker (formerly The Uniform Shop). Students may wear clothing from other sources provided it complies with the school uniform policy.

### Tops

- \* Uraidla PS Rugby Top – Navy and Red
- \* Uraidla PS Polar Fleece Jumper – Red or Navy  
Plain Red or Navy polar fleece or jumper with no logos

### Shirts

- \*Uraidla PS red or navy short sleeved or long sleeved polo shirt
- Plain red or navy T shirt with collar
- Plain red or navy skivvy under tunic

*No decorations, stripes or mixed red/blue items (Please note local sports team jumpers are not school uniform). Uraidla PS iron-on logos are available at the front office.*

### Pants

- \*Cargo pants [unisex] – Navy
- \*Girls bootleg pants – Navy
- Plain navy track pants
- \* Plain navy shorts [unisex]- 'fingertip' length

*Note: 'Fingertip' length means shorts and skirts should come to below your fingertips when your arms are by your side.*

### Dresses / Skirts

- \*Summer Uraidla PS dress  
Plain navy 'skort'
- \*Winter Uraidla PS tunic  
Plain navy skirt - 'fingertip' length

*No logo or stripe on pants / skirts. Plain navy tights and leggings can be worn under dresses and skirts.*

### Hats

\*Uraidla Primary School bucket or legionnaire's hats. A new hat is given to all new Reception students as a gift from the school community.

### Shoes

All school footwear needs to be sturdy and suitable for fitness and sport every day: sneakers is our preferred option. Boots / gumboots / lightweight sandals are not suitable for daily sport and fitness.

### Jewellery and accessories

No make-up or decorative jewellery, including bracelets, necklaces or rings. The only acceptable items are:

- Wristwatches.
- Plain earrings small studs or plain sleepers only.
- Plain hair accessories in navy or red or in school uniform fabric.
- Plain scarves and beanies in navy or red without pattern.

We understand that from time to time for a variety of reasons dressing children in the correct uniform may be difficult. In these times we ask parents to write a note to their child's class teacher explaining the circumstances. If we have not heard from you, and your child is not wearing the correct uniform, their class teacher will send a reminder by email or other form of communication, The Principal will contact the parent/guardian if a student consistently fails to follow Dress Code.
