



Uraidla Primary School Behaviour Procedures – Student Version

At school we all try to act according to our school motto:


LEARN: engaged, communicating, goal-setting, gritty, collaborative

STAND: respectful, inclusive, self-aware, brave, trustworthy

GIVE: empathetic, positive, kind, community-minded, grateful

FLY: innovative, challenge-seeking, flexible, curious, creative

In addition to general **Learn, Stand, Give, Fly** expectations, there are some specific rules you need to follow:



- Only bring toys to school for sharing (not for yard play).
- Use language appropriate for school.
- Speak respectfully to adults; do not 'talk back' or argue when asked to do something.
- Eat all food in the shelter shed; no food in pockets in the yard.
- Walk inside all buildings.
- Wear correct school uniform.
- Hats: If you have no hat, you play in the sand pit (not the gym). Wear hats outside only.
- Stay inside the school boundaries, including not behind the gym, sports shed, or garden sheds.
- Play touch football rules; no tackling.
- Playing in the bases is for recess and lunch, not before or after school.

When you having trouble with your behaviour the adults at school will help you. This is what will happen:

Step 1: Teachers will help you to make the right choices with a reminder. They will ask you to think about your behaviour. They might ask you to sit out of class for a while, or go to a buddy class. If you aren't doing the learning tasks your teacher has asked you to do, they might ask you to do the work at recess or lunch.

In the yard, the yard duty teacher might get you to walk with them or to sit out for 5 minutes in the shelter shed.

Step 2: If this doesn't work, or if what you have done is more serious, you will be sent to the office to talk to the Principal (or another teacher if the Principal is away). The Principal will decide what will happen next.

Step 3: If you have hurt or bullied others, destroyed property or been very rude and disrespectful to others, you will be asked to fill out a Behaviour Card, which will be sent home to your parents / caregivers to sign. If the incident is very serious, you may be suspended from school for 1 or more days.

*If you have upset or hurt others we will always help you talk it over together and help you make agreements about what you can all do to get along better. The Principal or Pastoral Care Worker can help you if you keep having problems getting along with others.

Dear parents / caregivers: Today your child displayed inappropriate behaviour, resulting in a formal Behaviour Card. Your child has had the opportunity to reflect on their behaviour and talk it through with at least one staff member. We would appreciate it if you could also discuss what happened with your child, so we can all work together to make sure this doesn't happen again. There is room for any comments you wish to make at the bottom of this page.
